

# CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT CHECKLIST - 2024

## Kingsley Pines - The Way Camp Should Be

Laundry is done weekly after the first week.

### REQUIRED CLOTHING

**Purchase Kingsley Pines required items directly from Maine Camp Outfitters.**

**We do NOT have any clothing at camp for your child to purchase.** Former campers may use Kingsley Pines T-shirts and sweatshirts purchased in previous years.

- \_\_\_\_\_ 3 Kingsley Pines red T-shirts
- \_\_\_\_\_ 1 Kingsley Pines red sweatshirt (hooded or crew)

### LAUNDRY BAG

- \_\_\_\_\_ 1 Kingsley Pines laundry bag

Former campers may bring a Kingsley Pines laundry bag from previous year, if you are a new camper or have lost your laundry bag, it will be provided to you at camp

### CLOTHING AND FOOTWEAR

- \_\_\_\_\_ 10 Pairs of all purpose socks
- \_\_\_\_\_ 10 Pairs of underwear
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4 Pairs of jeans or long pants
- \_\_\_\_\_ 5 Pairs of shorts
- \_\_\_\_\_ 8 Short sleeve shirts - t-shirts, polo knit shirts and/or tank tops
- \_\_\_\_\_ 1 Warm jacket or pullover
- \_\_\_\_\_ 1 Waterproof raincoat
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2 Pairs of pajamas
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2 Pair of flip flops or sandals
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2 Pairs of sneakers (very important to have at least 2 pairs in case 1 gets wet)
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2 Swimsuits (see dress code on page 2 of this checklist)
- \_\_\_\_\_ 1 Nice, casual outfit for dances

### TOILET ARTICLES

- \_\_\_\_\_ Toilet article carrying case or shower caddy
- \_\_\_\_\_ Soap
- \_\_\_\_\_ Toothbrush and toothpaste
- \_\_\_\_\_ Shampoo
- \_\_\_\_\_ Comb and/or brush
- \_\_\_\_\_ Nail clippers
- \_\_\_\_\_ Sunscreen
- \_\_\_\_\_ Insect repellent
- \_\_\_\_\_ Extra pair of glasses, if worn
- \_\_\_\_\_ Contact lenses and solution, if worn

### BEDDING AND TOWELS

These items are available for rent, except beach towels. To rent bedding, select this option on the Additional Expenses Form on your online account under Forms and Documents.

- \_\_\_\_\_ 3 Bath towels
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2 Beach towels
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2 Warm blankets
- \_\_\_\_\_ 1 Pillow
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2 Pillow cases
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2 Sets of twin sized sheets

It is a personal preference whether you use another flat sheet for the bottom sheet, or use a regular fitted sheet for the bottom. Campers are required to make their bunk beds with bed linens and sleep in them, not sleeping bags. Sleeping bags can be used as a comforter on a bed.

## **OTHER PERSONAL ITEMS**

**ALL clothing and equipment should be clearly marked with your child's first and last name (not just initials)**

## **DO NOT BRING:**

**Kingsley Pines is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged personal items, this includes clothes damaged by the laundry company.**

- Cell phones
- Digital cameras
- Bikes or skateboards of any kind
- Any device that can play or record video
- Any device, including smart watches that can connect to the Internet
- Any device that has any kind of video or electronic game
- Televisions
- DVD players
- Video cameras
- Computers or tablets
- eReaders (like Kindle)
- Walkie-Talkies
- Cash
- Food, candy, gum, silly string, or water balloons
- Aerosol cans
- Lighters or matches
- Expensive jewelry and/or watches
- Skateboards
- Firearms or other weapons
- Knives and hatchets
- Pets of any kind
- Other valuables

## **PACKING YOUR CHILD'S BELONGINGS**

We suggest you pack your child's items in a large suitcase or duffel bag with or without wheels. The bunk beds have 12.25 inches under the bottom bed. Trunks or similar containers are also allowed but must be 12.25 inches or less in height so they can be stored underneath the bed.

## **DRESS CODE**

Campers need to dress safely and suitably for camp so they can participate in all activities and have the most fun without worrying about their appearance or ruining their clothes in an activity. Our dress code is minimal and in keeping with everyone feeling safe and enjoying the outdoors. Campers need to understand our dress code ahead of time so they can pack appropriate clothing. They will be required to change if their clothing is deemed inappropriate.

- Clothing should fit comfortably and be designed for active wear. Avoid clothing that is overly tight, short or baggy.
- All clothing should cover undergarments.
- Tank tops and sleeveless shirts should fit appropriately and not have large, gaping arm holes that hang down exposing skin. Tank tops should be supportive and avoid halter and spaghetti strap style ties.
- Swimwear must be either a one-piece swimsuit that provides complete coverage or swim trunks (no shorts, cut-off pants, or Speedo) and a swim shirt that is designed for active wear if desired.
- Adventure activities such as the high rope and rock climbing that use a harness, require shorts with a minimum of a 5 inch inseam.
