

# ADIRONDACK CAMP PACKING LIST

This List is designed for the 4-Week Camper. If your child is another session, you may reduce or increase items accordingly. All items must be labeled with Camper's Name for laundry sorting with a water-proof sharpie or name label. Any items not labeled may not make it back to the correct camper. Laundry is done once a week and returned the next day.

## Clothing:

- 4 Adirondack **Required** Camp Logo Cotton Tees-Navy Blue
- 3 Pair Navy Blue Shorts (they can be your own)
- 6-8 T-Shirts (a mix short/long)
- 1-2 Sweatshirts (hooded optional)
- 1 Warm Sweater or Polar Fleece Jacket (It can be cool @ night)
- 4-8 Pair Shorts
- 3 Pair Pants (neat blue jeans ok w/belt if baggy) & Sweatpants
- 8-10 Pairs of Socks (campers change footwear often)
- 1-2 Pair of Underwear
- 2-3 Appropriate Bathing Suits
- 2-3 Pair Pajamas (1 warm)
- Raincoat w/Hood/Small Umbrella



## Bedding and Linen:

- 2 Warm Blankets (washable)
- 1 Pillow & 2 Pillow Cases
- 2 Sets Top Sheets (cot/twin size)
- 2 Sets Fitted Bottom Sheets
- 2-3 Bath-size Towels
- 1 Face Towel
- 1 Beach Towel
- 1 Laundry Bag

## Miscellaneous:

- Trunk/Duffel/Day Pack
- Water Bottle (Nalgene or other)
- Flashlight with Batteries (headlamp preferred)
- Sleeping Bag (for off-site and last night use)
- Inexpensive Cameras
- Leather Feathers** (for returning Campers & Braves)

## Suggested Items (as appropriate):

- Non-aerosol Bug Repellent
- Wet Weather Shoes/Boots/Rain Jacket/Umbrella (Required)
- Swim Goggles
- Magic Cards/Portable Chess/Backgammon Deck Cards
- Self-addressed Envelopes/Pens & Pencils/Stamps
- Books/Magazines/Comic Books
- Photo of Family/Friends/Favorite Stuffed Animal
- Casual Dressy for Dances (tops/skirts/sundresses ok)
- Plastic Hangers/Set of Drawers (home @ end of session)

## Toilet Articles:

- Shower Bucket/Tote
- Liquid Soap/Soap Dish/Toothbrush, Toothpaste
- Shampoo/Conditioner
- Hair Brush/Comb  
(pony-tail holders/scrunchies for girls)

## Footwear:

- 2 Pair of Sneakers
- Water Shoes (or Sandals)
- Rain Shoes [Crocs]/Flip-flops
- 1 Pair all-terrain shoes [or well broken in hiking boots] (optional)

## Optional:

- Frame Back Pack & Camping Equipment
- Crazy Creek Chairs
- Swiss Army/Leatherman Knives (must be kept in the Camp office)
- IPOD/MP3 players (must not be able to connect to the internet)
- Costumes/Props or Special Days
- Musical Instruments (We love when campers play!)
- Lacrosse Stick & Balls
- Fishing Equipment/Swim Fins & Mask

## **PLEASE DO NOT ALLOW YOUR CAMPER TO BRING:**

Cell Phones/IPhones (travel only)\*  
Money/Cash\* (not needed for out-of-camp trips)  
Food, Gum, or Candy  
Electronic Games  
Clothing with Offensive or Inappropriate Messages  
String Bikinis/1-Piece Suits are preferred for activities  
Electrical Appliances (blow dryer, curling iron etc.)  
Expensive Jewelry/Perfume/Cologne  
Knives/Pen Knives (not needed for out-of-camp trips)  
Matches/Lighters/Alcohol/Cigarettes/Vapes  
Fireworks of any kind

\*Travel exception. We can/will hold in camp office for safekeeping with passports and flight information.
